

Warner Library Code of Conduct Policy for Adults and Teens

The Warner Library staff, Director, and Trustees are committed to maintaining the Library as an inviting and vibrant place for everyone. To ensure that all users find a welcoming environment when they visit the Library, we ask that you abide by the following regulations:

- **No sleeping in the Library**
- **No food in the Library**
- **No smoking or illegal drugs in the Library**
- **No running in the Library**
- **No soliciting in the Library**
- **No loud conversations or shouting in the Library**
- **No stealing in the Library**
- **No use of offensive language**
- **No defacement of Library property**
- **No harassment of other patrons or staff**
- **No physical contact with other patrons**
- **No bare feet**
- **No pets or animals (other than guide dogs)**
- **No unscheduled meetings**

The Library Director may deny patrons who violate these rules and regulations Library access privileges. Any patron whose privileges have been denied may have the Director's decision reviewed by the Board of Trustees upon a request in writing.
